



## FILL THE FRAME

**Summary:** Taking close-up pictures of people

**Educational Value:**

- Through this activity you will learn to get closer to your subject with your camera / smartphone.
- This activity also touches on the ability of using the whole frame and explore composition.
- You will need to trust your ability to communicate with strangers to take a photo of them.

**Instructions:**

- Stop a random person in the street and ask them if you could take a picture of them.
- The idea is that you fill the frame with their picture, so you will need to get close.
- It could be intimidating to speak to strangers and take their picture, but this is the first step in exploring Trust.

**Set-up & Materials:**

- A digital camera or smart phone.

**Teaching Tips & Customization:**

- People like to be photographed, but it could be intimidating to speak to complete strangers.
- Get as close as possible to fill the frame.

**Labels:**

- Age: 4 + and above
- Time required: 60 minutes
- Materials: As above
- Type of activity: Art + Photography
- Themes: Close-ups
- Preferred children to teacher ratio: 5 to 1
